ITEMS WE CANNOT ACCEPT

(List is a guideline only and subject to changes)

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

- Blinds
- Ceiling fans & lighting that requires wiring in
- Old broom & mops
- Worn or soiled carpets
- Carpeting with unfinished edges
- Cassette tapes, tape holders & cases
- Computers
- Chipped or cracked dishes/ornaments
- Pots/pans/coffee pots that are burned or scratched
- Electrical items in need of repair
- Televisions
- Foamies, soiled pillows
- Garden hoses
- Suitcases with broken zippers, ripped, or worn edges
- Typewriter; manual or electric
- Wire hangers
- Foot baths
- Cordless Phones
- Bed Frames
- Cordless Phones

FURNITURE

- Book case head boards
- Hide a beds, waterbeds, metal spring beds, folding cots
- **General rule: anything that is NOT clean, free from stains, rips/tares, chips/breakage & odours**

APPLIANCES/ ELECTRONICS

- Large microwaves; or older than 5 years
- Washers, dryers, fridges, stoves, dishwashers, freezers
- Knitting machines

BOOKS/MAGAZINES

- Binders
- Encyclopaedias, Text Books
- Magazines older than 2 years
- Numbered sets (unless collectables)
- Readers digest

CLOTHING

- Used undergarments
- Clothing that is ripped, stained, odorous or has pet hair

SPORTING EQUIPMENT

- Bikes that are rusted
- Golf bags that are older and heavy
- Golf carts with narrow wheels
- Helmets older than 5 years & do not have CSA sticker
- Hockey sticks worn down
- Tents that are canvas

*BABY ITEMS

- Car seats
- Carry seats
- Tub seats
- Walkers
- Breast pumps

*Due to strict consumer guidelines condition of ALL baby items must be in excellent condition

MISCELLANEOUS

- Rusted BBQ'S & Camp Stoves
- Crutches, diabetic supplies
- Parts for automobiles, bikes or appliances, plumbing fixtures
- Building materials
- Used beauty products & toiletries

GENERALLY ANYTHING THAT IS: clean, free from stains, rips/tares, chips/ breakage, & odours. Items that are complete and NOT missing pieces. Electronics/appliances/books that are relatively up to date & compatible – WE ACCEPT
